[Boyle Transportation](#) (Bellerica, MA) Nominating Organization: DCMA Americas (Canada); Citation Brief: For customer focus, range of services, and participation in the EPA's "Smart Way Program," which enables DCMA Americas to comply with regulations and maintain environmental efficiencies.

[DB Schenker](#) (Newark, NJ) Nominating Organization: Commander Fleet Industrial Supply Center, San Diego, CA; Citation Brief: For innovative solutions allowing for expedited clearance and distribution within CONUS of retrograde material providing ATAC and Naval Inventory Control Point a head start on repairing and returning critical material to the War Fighter.
